National Atmospheric Research Laboratory (NARL) is an autonomous organization under Department of Space, Government of India. It is located at Gadanki, a place close to Tirupati. It is a premier institute engaged in carrying out frontline research in atmospheric and space sciences through observations, modelling and technology development.

2. NARL invites online applications for filling up the following vacancies:

(a) Name of the Position	Light Vehicle Driver (L V D) – A L- 2 (Rs.19,900 – 63,200/-) Rs.19,900/- per month + Admissible Allowance(s).
(b) No. of Positions	02 (Two); Category - UR
(c) Educational Qualifications	Pass in SSLC/SSC/Matric/10th Std.
(d) Experience	(i) 3 years experience as Light Vehicle Driver. (ii) Must possess valid LVD licence. (iii) Total prescribed experience should be after obtaining valid Driving Licence. (iv) Experience Certificate should only be from Government/Semi-Government agencies/Registered Companies/ Societies/ Trusts, etc. (v) Experience Certificate from individuals will not be accepted. (vi) Part time experience will not be considered for calculation of number of years of experience. (vii) Any other requirement of the Motor Vehicle Act of the concerned State in which the candidate is posted should be met within 3 months after the candidate joins the post. (viii) It is mandatory that the candidate should possess the requisite qualification and experience as on the last date of the application.
(e) Age limit	Cannot be more than 35 years as on last date of receipt of online application. Relaxation is applicable only for Ex-Servicemen applicants as per Govt. of India rules.

3. How to apply:

- The application for on-line registration will be hosted in the NARL web-site @ www.narl.gov.in during the period from 08.01.2022 to 07.02.2022.
- Candidates may visit NARL website to register their applications on-line between 08.01.2022 to 07.02.2022. Applications will be received on-line only.
- Upon registration, applicants will be provided with an on-line Registration Number, which should be carefully preserved for future reference.
- E-mail ID of the applicant will have to be provided in the application CORRECTLY and compulsorily.
- For those already in employment under Central/State Government, Public Sector Undertakings or Autonomous Bodies, the on-line application has to be invariably followed-up with a 'No Objection Certificate' from the employer concerned, duly indicating the name and Reg. No. on the reverse.

4. Selection process:

- (a) The candidate should have passed SSLC/SSC/Matric/10th Std. for submission of application online. Please note that the qualification prescribed is the MINIMUM requirement and the same does not automatically make candidates eligible for Written Test.
- (b) Written Test will be conducted either in Tirupati or in NARL, Gadanki.
- (c) Based on the performance in the Written Test, candidates will be short-listed for Skill Test. Those who qualify in the Skill Test will be purely on 'go-no-go' basis and marks obtained in Skill Test shall not be considered for selection. The Skill Test shall be evaluated on a 100 points scale with minimum 60% for qualification.
- (d) The final selection will be done, amongst qualified candidates, purely based on the score obtained in the Written Test. From amongst candidates who qualify in the Skill Test with minimum 60% marks, empanelment shall be done in the order of marks obtained in the Written Test. In case of a tie in written scores, the academic scores of the notified qualification shall be the tie breaker.
- (e) Written Test shall be conducted in such a way that theoretical and practical knowledge of the candidate is tested covering both breadth and depth of the prescribed curriculum.

5. Pay and Allowances :

- (a) Selected candidates will be appointed as Light Vehicle Driver-A in the pay band of Rs.19,900 – 63,200/- (L-2).
- (b) The gross emoluments in the minimum of pay band will at present be approximately Rs.19,900/-p.m. + Admissible Allowance(s).
- (c) The employees will be governed by the New Pension Scheme. On employment in NARL, Gadanki, other facilities are available such as medical facilities for self and dependants, subsidized canteen, transport allowance when official transport is not availed, limited housing facility for fresh entrants in lieu of HRA, Leave Travel Concession, Group Insurance, Construction of house, etc as per Central Government orders.

6. Other Conditions/Instructions :

- (a) The posts are temporary, but likely to continue.
- (b) The appointee be prepared to work in shifts, which may demand round the clock duty.
- (c) Candidates attending the Skill Test will be reimbursed to and fro second-class train fare by the shortest route from the city indicated in the on-line application form to the place of Skill Test. (change of address and city for the purpose will not be entertained)
- (d) Candidates called for Skill Test will have to produce all relevant original documents in proof of details furnished in their applications submitted on-line.
- (e) If any information furnished on-line is found to be wrong or false, the candidate will not be allowed for Skill Test and TA will not be paid.
- (f) No TA will be paid for attending the Written Test.
- (g) NARL reserves the right not to fill up all or any of the posts, if it so desires.
- (h) Only Indian nationals need apply.
- (i) No interim correspondence will be entertained.
- (j) In case of any clarification, candidates may send their mail to admin@narl.gov.in.
- (k) It is for the candidate to ensure to fulfill the eligibility criteria, comply with the requirements, and adhere to the instructions contained in this advertisement as well as in the application form.
- (l) Candidates are, therefore, urged to carefully read the advertisement and complete the application form and submit the same as per instructions given in this regard.
- (m) The detailed syllabus for Written Test is enclosed in the Annexure – A.
